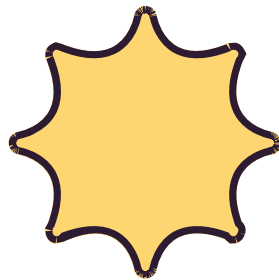

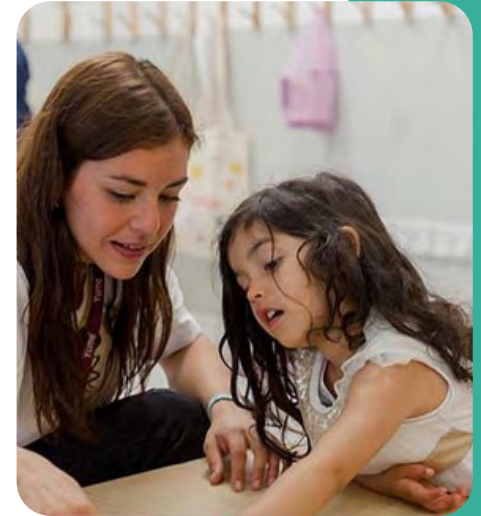
Babies Room

On the first stage, our Baby Room is purposefully designed to support the care aspect of young children (aged 3 months to 14 months). A safe, exploratory environment suited for young babies' needs, including cozy sleep room, first independent movements and feeding. On a second stage, Yüme Babies will enable a transition period into toddling, including space to promote further interactions (between peers), and more room for young children to move around freely, explore, and develop further their communication skills.



Preschool Room

Yüme Preschool is a room for creators & big thinkers: children face new challenges and come up with their own ideas, along with focusing on key concepts and routines required for their transition into primary school. Children here will focus on their school readiness capabilities, including more advanced resources and activities, that promote their academic development, along with their emotional and interpersonal skills.



Baby Toddlers & Toddlers Room

Yüme Toddlers & Baby Toddlers share our biggest room in the house. It promotes children's independence and confidence, developing new interests and skills through learning situations that focus on their communication & physical capabilities. Transition between age groups is typically at 2 years old.



Our Approach

Immersed in a purposeful play space, Yüme Children are actively encouraged to explore, be curious, appreciate culture, scientific inquiry and find interest in new themes through hands-on activities and cross-curricular Learning Units and Skills programmes.

Inquiry Based Learning

Our Reggio inspired approach promotes curiosity in children, introducing new ideas, and knowledge that comes from the children's own questions. It's not just the educator that imparts knowledge: we challenge children with real or imaginary scenarios, that allow them to develop their own learning experiences.

Pedagogy of Play

Play is at the center of all our activities and learning opportunities at Yüme. This pedagogy embraces both free and structured play, as they allow children to understand their (place in the) world, make friendships, and test or risk-assess ideas through engaging activities.

Resources & Environment

Our exploratory environments promote children's independence, encouraging them to explore and make their own choices on the activities or resources they want to engage with. We promote the use of natural / wooden resources, over plastic, and include loose parts (for open ended exploration) and Montessori resources, for their academic value in areas of literacy, maths and understanding of the world.



Yüme **Extras**

Yüme Wandsworth offers children an enhanced learning experience, combining the fundamentals of EYFS with extra-curricular sessions that promote their physical development, areas of interest and knowledge. Yüme Extras sometimes operate on a term-time basis, and are based on scheduling availability.

Forest School Trips

3 – 4 years old

Twice a month

Children are immersed in explorations and challenges in Nature.

Dance & Ballet

2 – 4 years old

Once a week

Introduction to ballet, promoting good balance, coordination and expression through dance.

Baby Yoga

14 - 24 months

Once a week

Introduction to poses, movements and stretching exercises for little ones.

STEM Sessions

2 - 4 years old

Once a week

Exploratory activities with different learning outcomes related to science, technology, engineering and maths.

PE & Sports

2 - 4 years old

Once a week

In collaboration with a Sports coach offering basket, football, volleyball, golf, and other sports.

Spanish

3 months - 4 years old

Monday to Friday (everyday)

Designed around the seven strands of the EYFS curriculum to link children everyday learning.

French

2 - 4 years old

Once a week

Introduction to French through songs, games, actions story-telling and drama.



We are an International Community

Living in one of the most cosmopolitan cities in the world, we promote multiple languages development from the earliest stages, as this is proven to have a great impact on children's cognitive development.

Native Speaker-led interactions

Between 40-60% of the World's population are considered to be bilingual. This is represented by the team at Yüme, an experienced group of internationally trained educators and professionals who ensure each child receives the support and learning experience that their family requires.

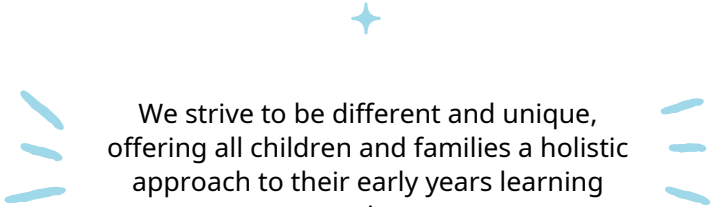
How do languages work at Yüme?

Our nursery offers an immersive language experience environment with native speakers. Plus, complimentary languages such as French, Mandarin and Korean are also introduced as a Language Programmes both for parents & children.

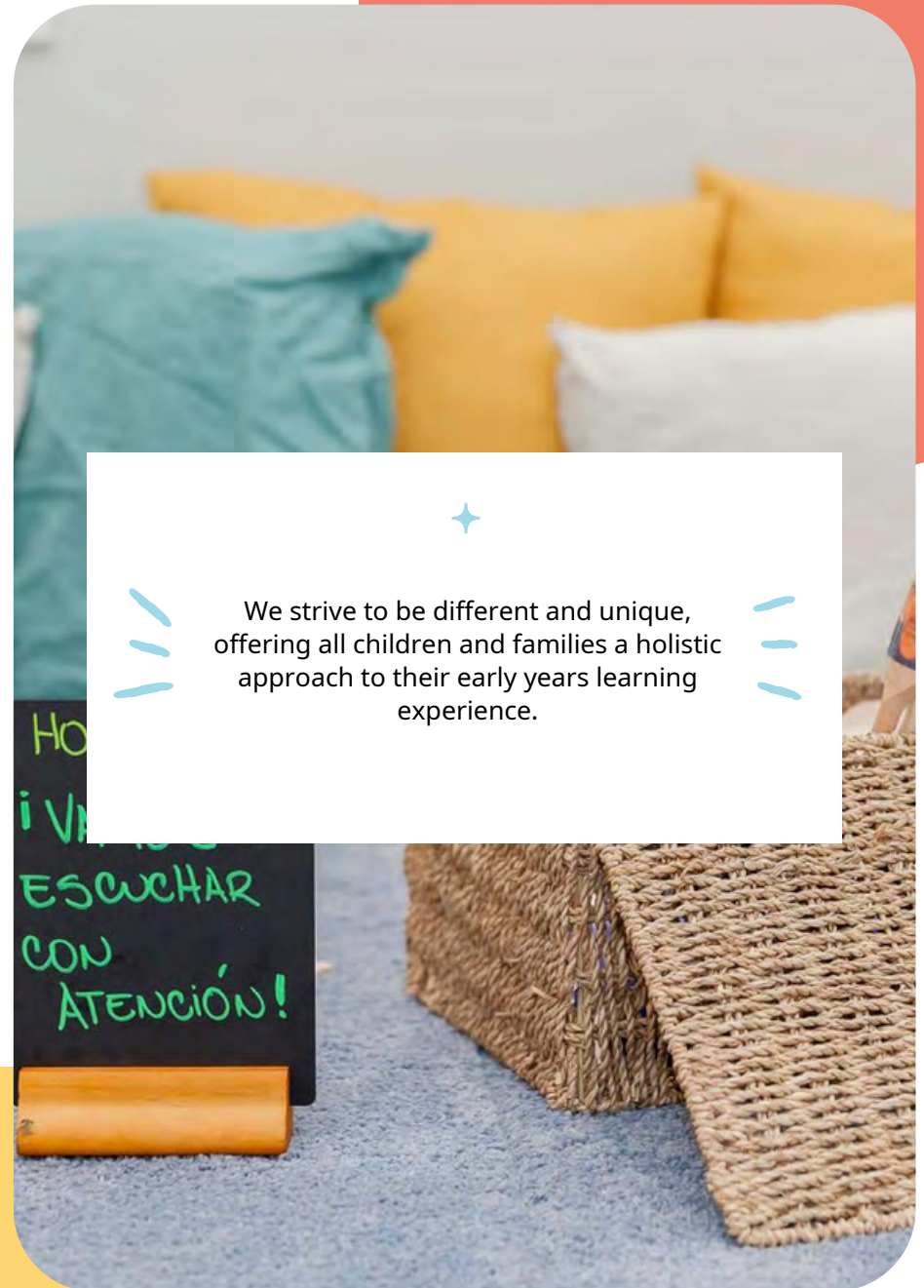
Each family can choose their child's key person (and buddy key person) to address them in their native language if desired, along with the option of English being the exclusive/predominant language your child is exposed to.

Is learning two languages at the same time confusing for children?

Yes and no. It is true that children may find learning two or more languages at the same time more challenging. However, it's been proven through extensive research that in the long term, children's language abilities are not delayed or impaired, while, in fact, multilingualism provides a stronger cognitive development, and a personal (and eventually) professional advantage.



We strive to be different and unique, offering all children and families a holistic approach to their early years learning experience.



Outdoor Learning

We promote early years PE and outdoor learning, as a natural approach to children's physical development and wellbeing. Nature around us has the power to stimulate and amaze children. To help them develop life skills, self-confidence and curiosity.

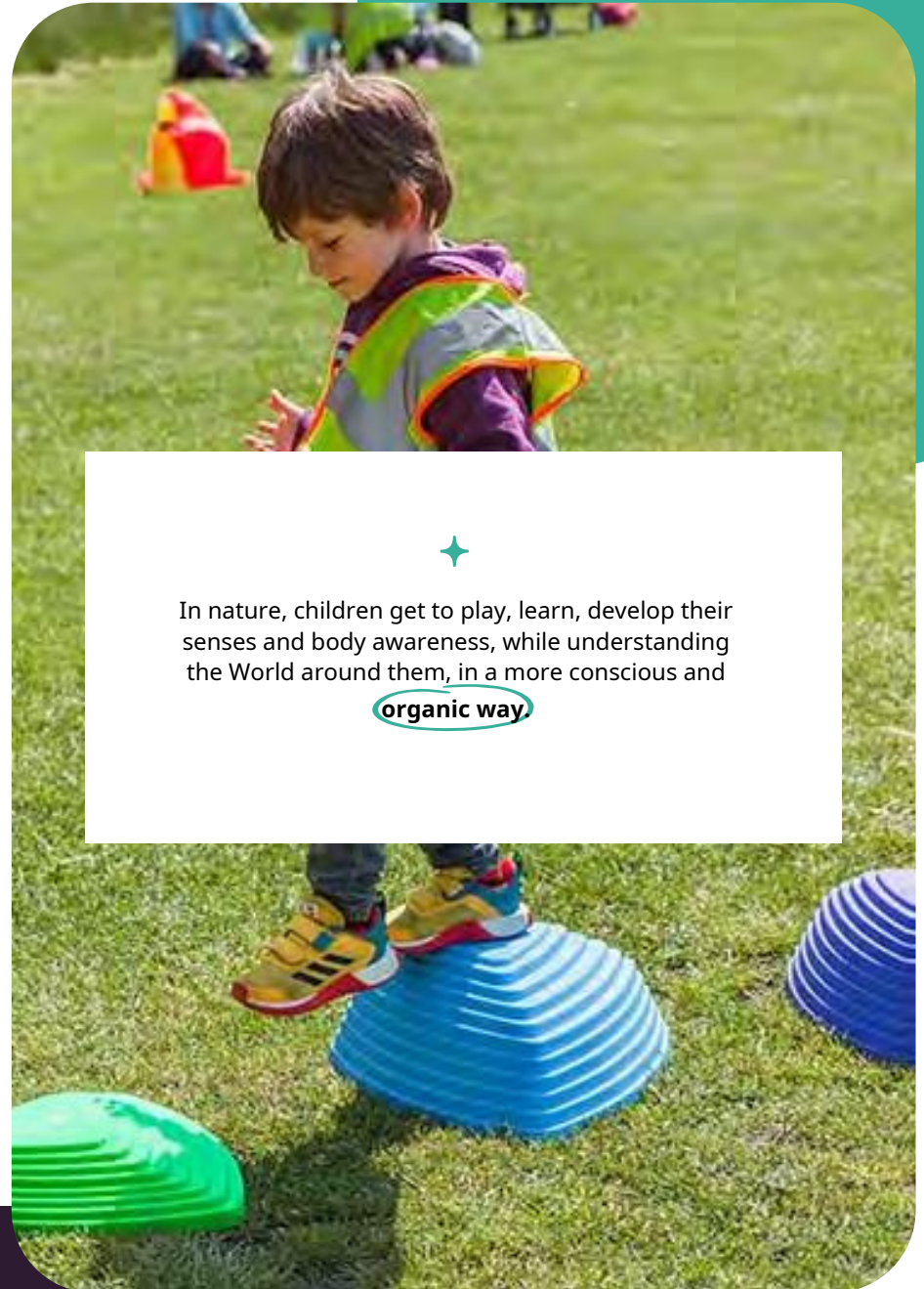
Exploring in Nature.

Our Yüme Outdoor Learning programme includes regular visits to Wandsworth park and the river Thames, both in the morning & in the afternoons (all age groups).



Children will engage in team sports, exploring shapes, numbers and colours in nature, learning "survival" skills, and understanding key elements on what changes the Natural World experiences through the year.

Children will have additional **Forest School** day trips to London landmarks including Richmond Park, Bushy Park, Wimbledon Commons, and more.

Yüme Kitchen

We serve high-quality food, prepared freshly in our onsite kitchen, with no added sugar, salt or saturated fat (apart from olive oil) included in our meals.

We encourage children to eat independently from early stages, and introduce diverse fruit, vegetables and more healthy ingredients based on a diverse Mediterranean diet.



Our six-weeks menu, changes every season and it includes recipes provided by our parents, to celebrate our different cultural backgrounds, through the food we eat as well!

Our trained chef, along with the nursery management team, monitor regularly all of children's dietary preferences and allergies, along with ensuring the kitchen's compliance with mandatory guidelines.
